

During the MultiEd project implementation (2019-2023), Zaporizhzhia National University achieved the following results:

- 1. The project enhanced the potential of 63 academic staff through 22 MultiEd courses, internships, and study visits we took part in. We also enhanced the academic potential and job employability of 716 students of different levels. We participated in all the content, quality, dissemination, and managerial events.
